


CHALLENGE MECHANISM: The first four sessions of the course will consist of written and practical testing for those individuals who would like to challenge out of sessions in the course. (1) Written testing will consist of four 50-question examinations designed to identify strengths/weaknesses in sections of the course. (2) Practical testing will include the NYS Basic EMT Testing Stations.

COST? Tuition of \$335.00 will be charged to individuals who are not members of a NYS First Response Agency or Ambulance EMS Agency.

DATES? The course will begin on Tuesday, February 3, 2015 at 7:00 pm and will be given on Tuesday evenings with three Saturday Sessions. The course concludes with the NYS Written Examination to be held on Thursday, May 21, 2015.
